Dear Mr. Reed,

On October 18, 2024 the initial meeting took place to review allegations that the Beta Theta Pi Fraternity violated the IFC Risk Management Policies during a party hosted on or around October 5th, 2024. Based on the totality of the information available and disclosed during the meeting, there is sufficient evidence to find the fraternity responsible for the alleged incidents. Due to your acceptance of responsibility, the following sanctions will be enacted:

1. Warning: This document serves as a written reprimand to Beta Theta Pi and officially informs the chapter that any further violation of IFC bylaws and/or policies, or University policies, may result in more severe sanctioning through the IFC judicial process.

During our meetings, Beta Theta Pi expressed interest in future joint events. It is crucial that the forms for these events contain the correct information and are submitted to IFC with the proper time to be approved by both IFC and OFSL. As a reminder, the submission of incomplete forms or hosting of events without approval are violations of the IFC Risk Management Policy.

2. Social & Risk Meeting: The Beta Theta Pi Executive Board representatives in charge of Social and Risk Management responsibilities are required to attend a meeting with the IFC Chief Justice regarding this issue. This meeting will provide information regarding the scheduling and hosting of social events. The IFC VP of Risk Management may attend this meeting.

This meeting must happen before November 22, 2024 (Friday of Week 8). Furthermore, as the Beta Theta Pi Executive Board will be changing over within the next quarter, the information from this meeting must be relayed to the newly-elected Executive Board within a week of their election. Proof in writing of this meeting, including the content discussed and Executive Board members in attendance, must be sent to the IFC Chief Justice and VP of Risk Management via email.

Should you want to follow up on the request, or need assistance moving forward please do not hesitate to ask. We appreciate your cooperation in closing this matter. If you have any concerns moving forward, please let us know.

If you should decide to appeal these sanctions, the request must be made within 5 business days of receiving this letter. The request should be sent to the Chief Justice and
